4 reserve gymnasts will be nominated.

The 8 highest ranked gymnasts in the qualifying competition C I per apparatus will qualify for the apparatus finals C III

3 reserve gymnasts will be nominated for each final

3.1 The qualifying competition (C I)

The starting order of the competition is made according to the draw of lots carried out in Győr, on April 26th, 2017 by the Technical Delegates and Organizing Committee during Chefs de Mission Seminar.





- In case of a tie at any position at the end of the competition, the tie breaking rules set out in FIG/TR will apply.
- If a qualified gymnast is prevented from taking part in the competition C II, then the next gymnast from that NOC can replace him/her, if his/her result is better than that of the first reserve. The reserve will take the starting position of the gymnast they replace.
- Withdrawals/replacements of gymnasts are to be submitted to:

- In case of a tie at any places in competition I, the tie breaking rules set out in FIG/TR will apply.
- If a qualified gymnast is prevented from taking part in the competition C III, then he/she can be replaced by the next gymnast from his/her NOC, on the condition that his/her result is better than that of the first reserve. The reserve will take over the starting position of the gymnast he/she replaces.
- Withdrawals/replacements of gymnasts are to be submitted to
 - o For the MAG competition to Mr. Tom THINGVOLD, the MAG Technical Delegate
 - o For the WAG competition to Mrs. Satu MURTONEN, the WAG Technical Delegate
- The general warm-up will take place in the warm-up hall. After the general warm-up, the gymnasts will have the possibility to train on the podium in the competition hall before the apparatus finals, on Friday and on Saturday.
- If more than 8 gymnasts are qualified in one apparatus final, another draw of lots will take place, according to the number of qualified gymnasts.

3.4 Access to the competition area

The competition area is accessible to members of the various juries, competing gymnasts and their accredited coaches, to local group leaders, to the auxiliary personnel of the Jury, to the official doctor, to the team doctors, medical staff and to persons concerned with the apparatus as well as the LOC personnel.

Interpreters may not enter the competition area without the permission of the Technical Delegate. The competition area is strictly forbidden to all other persons.

If a gymnast is not competing on all apparatus, he/she has the right to leave the competition area and warm-up in the warm-up hall. It is the responsibility of the gymnast to return to the competition hall for his/her next apparatus. The gymnast may return quietly in his/her own time.

Concerning the presence of the coaches and medical team on the podium, the following provisions will apply:

Qualifying Competition (C I):

- 2-3 gymnasts – maximum 2 coaches
- 1 gymnast – 1 coach

All-Around Finals (C II) and Apparatus Finals (C III):

- each gymnast – 1 coach

For all competitions, 1 team medical person per NOC is allowed

Judges may attend training sessions.

3.5 Use of electronic communication devices

The use of mobile phones or any other electronic communication device by gymnasts, coaches, judges or medical staff of the delegations on the field of play is forbidden during the entire duration of the competitions.

If this rule is violated, the concerned persons will receive a written warning.

If this behaviour is repeated after the written warning is issued, the concerned person will be excluded for the rest of the competition.

3.6 Award ceremonies

The ceremonies take place immediately after the competition in the competition venue

- For Team competition – 3 teams on the podium
- For All-Around Finals – 3 gymnasts on the podium
- For Apparatus Finals – 3 gymnasts per apparatus on the podium

In accordance with the FIG TR, gymnasts are requested to wear competition attire during the awarding ceremonies.

3.7 Apparatus supplier

The apparatus supplier is Spieth.

3.8 Scoring and distribution of results

After each competition, the results will be provided on Internet on the official website of EYOF www.gyor2017.hu

At the end of the competition all delegations will be provided with a complete set of results including the judges' individual scores for all competitions by e-mail.

3.9 Technical meeting

The presence of the participating NOC to the technical meeting is mandatory.
A maximum of 2 members per NOC and discipline.

3.10 Competition numbers

The competitions numbers (bib numbers) will be provided to the NOC at the end of the Technical Meeting. The numbers are to be firmly attached to the competition attire throughout the whole competition.

3.11 Written exercises / WAG only

It would be appreciated if NOC would submit the gymnasts' exercises in symbols notation at the podium training at the very latest.



FIG Statutes 2017 – appendix 3 – Code of Ethics

Any close family relative to a competitive gymnast may not judge that gymnast or his/her unit (pair, group, etc.) at any FIG sanctioned event.

4.2.1 The D-jury

The D-jury has been nominated by the Technical Delegates according to the category of the judges in current FIG cycle. The D-jury will remain the same throughout the competition.

4.2.2 The E-jury

The E judges will be decided by the drawing of lots on site.

In case there are insufficient numbers of judges from the participating present NOCs, the Technical Delegates and Organizing Committee will appoint the necessary number of judges from the host NOC.

For competition C III, only judges from NOC without qualified gymnasts (including 1st reserve) can judge in the E-jury panel at the respective apparatus, if possible.

4.3 Judges' instruction and draw of lots

According to the FIG/UEG/TR, the presence of the judges to the judges' instruction is mandatory. The judges' instruction will be held in English.

The judges' oath will be carried out at the end of the judges' instruction, by one of the host federation's judge.

4.4 Inquiries of the score

According to UEG TR.

If the inquiry is refused, the amount will be invoiced later on from the UEG Office and must be paid within 3 months. If the inquiry is accepted, no amount will be requested.

The inquiry must be confirmed as soon as possible in writing, but within 4 minutes at the latest after the verbal inquiry and requires an agreement of payment of Euro 300.- for the first complaint; Euro 500.- for the second complaint and Euro 1'000.- for the third and any further complaints for each distinct championship (i.e. the EYOF MAG is distinct from the EYOF WAG). The detailed procedure is laid down in the Technical Regulations of the FIG.

5 THE ORGANIZATION OF THE EVENT

5.1 Training information

According to the schedules.

5.2 Official podium training

A detailed program of the official podium training will be provided to the participating NOCs. According to the FIG/TR, the presence of the judges at the official podium training is mandatory.

5.3 Delegations

Each NOC with 1 or more gymnasts has the obligation to nominate 1 judge. The judges have to fulfil the requirements of the FIG/TR. All judges must be holders of a valid FIG judges brevet.

Gymnasts who do not have correct age and a valid FIG license (or the validity of the license is expired) are not allowed to compete. All licenses will be checked by the LOC after the nominative inscriptions.

The 13th European Youth Olympic Festival for Men and Women, Győr (HUN) 2017, will take place under the following current regulations:

- FIG and UEG Statutes
- FIG and UEG Technical Regulation
- FIG General Judges' Rules
- FIG Specific Judges' Rules
- FIG CoP modifications for Junior Competitions, and relevant Newsletters and Help Desk (WAG)
- The Artistic Gymnastics Technical Manual
- Artistic Gymnastics Work Plan
- Rules of the World Anti-Doping Code shall apply in accordance with the instructions of the EOC
- FIG Licence rules
- FIG Apparatus Norms
- FIG Rules for Sanctioning (approval) of International Events
- The advertising rules of the EYOF Charter overrule the FIG Advertising rules and subsequent decisions of the FIG and UEG Executive Committee

The Technical Delegates will handle unforeseen incidents or events that might occur during EYOF.
